### Florida State Touring Roster/Arts on Tour (for presenters in Florida)

Purnama Sari is acknowledged by the state of Florida for their high quality performance and professionalism and is featured in the 2014-2016 Florida State Touring Roster. Any non profit Florida organizations outside Sarasota county (Purnama Sari's home base) including community theaters, art centers, public schools, libraries, and museums are eligible for grants that support up to two third of an artist fee. ### Southern Arts (for presenters in Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee)

#### ***Southern Fast Track Touring***

This grant program offers smaller presenting organizations in South Arts' nine-state region the opportunity to receive fee support to present performing artists and writers from outside the presenter's state. Support is awarded to theatre, music, opera, musical theatre, literary, and dance projects that contain both a public performance or reading and an educational component. The maximum request is 50% of the artist fee, up to \$2,500. **Applications must be submitted online at least 60 days prior to the project start date.** All grant requests are subject to funding availability. Grants are awarded on a first come/first served basis until funding is depleted. Early submission is encouraged. #### ***Regional Touring***
