### Mask Dances from Bali

### Shadow Puppet Theatre



Be mesmerized by mysterious shadow puppets from Bali! Accompanying Balinese music (*gamelan*) further enhances dramatic effect and carries the audience to the mythological kingdom in the Ramayana, the great Hindu epic. Children and their parents will enjoy the adventurous story with the universal message of heroism and friendship. This performance can be offered with a shadow puppet making workshop. PreK—5th grade children will learn how to make a shadow puppet with a movable part. Various puppet templates will be available for young children. Upon completing puppet making, the children will have an opportunity to try their puppet with the screen and light. This workshop has been well received at public libraries and schools.
